**RULE ON CREW MEMBERSHIP & THE DEFINITIONS AS AGREED AT THE EGM HELD ON SATURDAY 30 SEPTEMBER, 2000**

**7.0 Crew Member:** A Member who has been nominated by a Full Member who wishes the nominee to crew for him on a regular basis. The person so nominated can then be admitted by the General Committee to such membership for a period not exceeding twelve months expiring on the next 31<sup>st</sup> December for a subscription as determined by the General Committee. A person may be nominated in successive years but admission after the initial year will be dependent on the satisfactory completion of a log book during each previous season. A Crew Member is not entitled to bring a boat to the Club nor own a boat or share of a boat kept at the Club nor introduce visitors.

**CONDITIONS OF JUNIOR CREW MEMBERSHIP**

1. Junior Crew Members must be sponsored by a Full member who will be responsible for the crew at all times both afloat and ashore.
2. Junior Crew Members may be re-elected annually, subject to the satisfactory completion of a log book during the previous season.
3. Junior Crew Members may be able to remain as crew members until they reach 19 yrs of age, on the understanding they satisfy the criteria in points 1 and 2 above.
4. Junior Crew Membership subscription will be 50% of the Junior subscription level.
5. Junior Crew Members may use the Clubhouse and its facilities at all times.
6. Junior Crew Members may not bring a boat to the Club, nor own a boat or share a boat kept at the Club.
7. Crew Members may not sign in visitors.
