NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Exoneration Penalty and the Advisory Hearing and RYA Arbitration of the RYA Rules Disputes Procedures will be available.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the RS200, 420, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Mirror, Topper, Cadet, Poole Harbour AB, Laser Pico and Optimist classes with helm and crews under the age of 19 on 31st December 2010.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Parkstone Yacht Club, Pearce Avenue, Parkstone, Poole, Dorset, BH14 8EH by 23rd July 2010.
- 3.3 Late entries will be accepted under at the discretion of the organisers, at double normal entry fee
- 3.4 To enter Youth Week 2010 and sail a Laser Pico, youngsters shall have participated in RYA OnBoard sessions through one of the recognised RYA OnBoard Clubs/Centres as listed below, should not have their own sailing dinghy and should not be members of a sailing club. Youngsters shall be able to sail to at least RYA Stage 2 standard. Eligible recognised RYA OnBoard Clubs or Centres are:

Swanage Sailing Club, Poole Yacht Club, Parkstone Yacht Club, Hengistbury Head, Harbour Challenge, Rockley Watersports and Spinnaker Sailing Club

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration on Saturday 31st July.

7 VENUE

Racing shall take place on two course areas within Poole Harbour.

8 THE COURSES

The courses will be ad-hoc using a mixture of fixed and movable marks. Windward-Leeward courses will be used for the RS200 class. The Sailing instructions may include other fixed courses.

9 SCORING

One race shall constitute a series.

- (a) When fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When from 4 to 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When 7 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

10 OFFICIAL BOATS

Official boats shall be marked with a green flag. All other support boats shall keep clear of the race area during racing.

11 PRIZES

A winner's trophy and other prizes will be awarded in each class

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

21 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of two million pounds per event or the equivalent and have signed indemnities from a person holding parental responsibility under the Children's Act 1989.
