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PARKSTONE YACHT CLUB SAILING INSTRUCTIONS 2010 EDITION

1.0 RULES

- 1.1 Racing** will take place under the current International Sailing Federation (ISAF) Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the RYA, these Sailing Instructions (SIs) and the appropriate Class Rules.
- 1.2** Boats in all classes are allowed to advertise as per category 'C' as detailed in ISAF regulation 20, unless the appropriate Class Rules classify them as category 'A'.
- 1.3** Multihull and J24 Classes Penalties: A boat that may have broken a rule of Part 2 of RRS while racing may take a One-Turn penalty. This alters RRS 44.1. Other requirements of RRS 44.1 remain unaltered. A boat taking such a penalty will follow the requirements of RRS 44.2.

2.0 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 2.1 General:** The safety of a boat and its entire management including Insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/person in charge, who must ensure that the boat and crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of a race. Neither these Sailing Instructions nor any inspection of the boat limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the owner/person in charge for the crew, the boat and its management, including compliance with Poole Harbour Byelaws.

2.2 Liability.

- 2.2.1** The race organisers shall not be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner/person in charge or crew as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Further, every owner/person in charge warrants the suitability of the boat for the race or races and that they will draw the attention of their crew to this Sailing Instruction.
- 2.2.2** All competing boats shall be insured to a third party liability minimum of **£2,000,000**.

2.2.3 The provision of safety equipment and boats by Parkstone Yacht Club is neither a guarantee that assistance can be rendered to any competitor in need, nor an acceptance of any responsibility for rescue of competitors. Further, in the event that any assistance is rendered to a competitor, no liability for any loss, damage or injury to the competitor, and/or the boat and its equipment is accepted either by the club or the crew of such safety craft.

2.3 Eligibility: Other than in a race designated as an open event, competing boats shall be steered by a member of Parkstone Yacht Club; however the helm may be taken temporarily by another hand. Eligibility for trophy races shall be determined by the conditions of that trophy as detailed in the Parkstone Yacht Club Schedule of Cups and Trophies, and /or Class Rules.

2.4 Entry Form: No boat may race unless a current Entry Form for the relevant series (together with a Junior Waiver Form, if applicable) has been completed and accepted by the Club Office.

2.5 Distinguishing Numbers: The prior permission of the Race Officer shall be obtained before any boat uses sails carrying a distinguishing number other than that required by RRS 77. Such permission shall be given only in exceptional circumstances.

3.0 SAFETY

3.1 Attention is drawn to RRS Fundamental Rules 1 and 4.

3.2 Personal Floatation Devices.

3.2.1 Junior Competitors: All non-cruiser class competitors under the age of eighteen shall wear adequate personal personal floatation devices at all times when afloat. This changes RRS 40

3.2.2 Dinghies, Multihull and Day Keel Boats: Adequate personal floatation devices shall be worn during races that include marks in the Swash Channel, Poole or Studland Bays. This changes RRS 40

3.3 Cruiser, J24 XOD and Shrimper Classes.

3.3.1 One Design Classes: All competitors shall conform to the safety requirements of their respective Class Rules.

3.3.2 All Other Classes: All competitors shall conform to the requirements of ORC Category 4 and be issued with a minimum SSSN 10, or equivalent.

3.3.3 All Cruiser Classes, J24, XOD and Shrimper Classes: All competing boats shall carry a working VHF radio transceiver.

3.4 Before going afloat

3.4.1 Intention to Compete: A competitor from each boat in all non-motorised dinghy and keelboat classes (not youth classes) must complete the appropriate class declaration form located in the sailing office before going afloat. Any boat that fails to comply with this requirement will be deemed to have retired.

3.4.2 Tallying: Dinghy, multihull, and non-motorised keel boat classes: Helms and crews shall also collect a personal tally from the Beachmaster's Office prior to going afloat and wear it whilst afloat.

3.5 On coming ashore

3.5.1 Tallies must be returned to the Beachmaster's Office promptly and no later than 30 minutes after coming ashore. Competitors who fail to comply with any aspect of 3.4.2 or this rule shall be subject to disqualification without a hearing. This alters RRS 63.1.

3.5.2 Declaration of Retirement:

Cruiser, J24, Shrimper and XOD classes (XOD, Monday series only): Notify the Race Officer by VHF radio.

Adult Dinghy, Multi-hull and Day Keelboats classes: Sign the class declaration form on coming ashore.

Youth classes: Report to a safety boat on the water and to the Beachmaster on coming ashore.

3.5.3 Racing Abandoned: In the event of racing being abandoned, competitors should ensure that tallies are returned to the Beachmaster's Office as quickly as possible.

3.6 Commercial Shipping/Other Harbour Users.

3.6.1 Competing boats must not navigate in such a manner so as to interfere with the safe navigation of vessels that are constrained in their ability to manoeuvre.

3.6.2 Exclusion Zone: In the event that a commercial vessel is preceded by a Club RIB, Launch, or a Harbour master's vessel flying IC Flag U, any competing boat passing between that RIB, or Launch, and the commercial vessel is liable to disqualification without a hearing. The chain ferry is a commercial vessel for the purposes of these instructions.

This alters RRS 63.1.

- 3.6.3** Any competitor found to be in breach of 3.6.2 is liable to further disqualification from the race series and may be required to appear before the General Committee under PYC Club Rule 13 (Expulsion or Suspension of Members).
- 3.6.4 Propulsion to avoid commercial shipping:** In order to avoid a collision with a vessel constrained in its ability to manoeuvre, a competitor may use sufficient alternative propulsion in order to remove itself from immediate danger. The competitor may continue to race after this, so long as the avoiding action confers no advantage in the race. This must be declared using the same arrangements for declaration of retirement as in 3.5.2. **This alters RRS 42.1**

4.0 COMMUNICATION WITH COMPETITORS

- 4.1** VHF communication will normally take place on Channel M (37a).
- 4.2** Warning Flags will be as shown in the Sailing Programme published in the current year's Parkstone Yacht Club Annual Handbook.
- 4.3** Warning Signal Times will be listed in the fixture list published in the current year's Sailing Programme. Where no time is so published, the start time will be posted in the Sailing Office two hours before the start of the race.
- 4.4** Flag Signals Ashore will be made on the club flagstaff.
- 4.4.1** When a Postponement has been signalled ashore, the lowering of that signal indicates that competitors should proceed directly to the race area. The lowering of the Postponement signal on the Race Platform or Committee Boat will indicate the start of the race sequence. This alters RRS Part 3.
- 4.4.2 Winter series:** the following coloured flags flown over a signal will apply to the following classes: -
- Purple - all adult dinghy classes, including Dart, Flying 15 and Laser Radial.
- Yellow - all Parkstone organised cruiser and J24 racing.
- White - all Youth classes.
- 4.5** Notices to Competitors will be posted in the Sailing Office.
- 4.6** Amendments to these Sailing Instructions will be posted in the Sailing Office for two hours before the advertised start time of the race, or races, concerned.

4.7 Signalling of Course to be Sailed.

- 4.7.1 All classes other than in 4.7.3 and 4.7.4 below:** The course to be sailed will be displayed before the Warning Signal by means of indicator boards displayed from the Race Platform or the Committee Boat. Where a course is preceded by one or more Class board(s) that course shall apply only to those classes. This modifies RRS 27.1
- 4.7.2** The 'First Mark' (where not specified in numbered courses) will be identified by an indicator board displayed on the Race Platform or Committee Boat immediately following the course number concerned. This will signify a mark as set out in SI 13. The background colour of any letter or symbol board displayed is irrelevant in this context.
- 4.7.3** Monday Evening Cruiser, J24, XOD and Shrimper Series, The course to be sailed will be announced on VHF radio at approximately 10 minutes and 5 minutes before the first class Warning Signal. This modifies RRS 27.1. These classes are required to maintain a radio watch on this working channel prior to the start and until finishing or retiring.
- 4.7.4** Monday Evening Dinghy Series. The course to be sailed by all Classes will, together with the number of rounds, be displayed on a board on the Committee Boat before the Warning Signal of the first class to start.

4.8 Signalling of Alternative Committee Boat Start.

- 4.8.1** When racing is to start from a Committee Boat (normally 'Ron Cox') a large Orange Flag shall be flown from the club flagstaff, no later than 1 hour 30mins before the first advertised start time on a Saturday, and no later than 1730 BST when evening racing is to take place.
- 4.8.2** When the Orange Flag is flown alone, the Committee Boat start signal applies to all classes racing. When flown above class warning flags, the Committee Boat start only applies to those classes.
- 4.8.3** The provisional position of the Committee Boat will normally be written on a board outside the Sailing Office.

4.9 Signalling Race Platform Finish Line 2: When a Blue Flag is flown from the Race Platform, all classes will use Finish Line 2 when completing rounds or finishing the race.

4.10 Signalling when a Second Race is to be Sailed.

4.10.1 A large Pink Flag flown ashore no less than one hour before the first start indicates a second race to be sailed by all classes. If flown over class flags it only applies to those classes.

4.10.2 Monday Evening Dinghy Series, Two Race Evenings: When the Committee Boat is flying Numeral 2 a second race will start shortly after the finish of the first race.

5.0 STARTING RACES

5.1 Starting procedures will be in accordance with RRS Part 3.

5.2 Start Line: Shall be between the Black and Yellow Staff and an Outer Distance Mark, which will be a buoy with an Orange flag.

5.3 Alternative Start line: The Outer Distance Mark may be an alternative designated marker. This will be defined by VHF radio.

5.4 Starting a Second Race: When a second race is to be sailed as in SI 4.10 the start for a fleet will take place as soon as possible after the last boat of that fleet has finished the first race.

6.0 GENERAL RECALLS.

6.1 A class that has two General Recalls may have its start for that race delayed until all other classes have started.

7.0 SAILING THE COURSE.

7.1 The course shall be sailed in accordance with RRS 28, except where a course specifically includes a harbour channel, as in 7.5 below.

7.2 When courses are sailed which include marks in the Swash Channel, Poole Bay, or Studland Bay, boats shall not pass through an exclusion zone between North Haven Beacon and the Sandbanks' shore.

7.3 Multihull classes only:

7.3.1 Courses followed by (MHx2) are to be sailed TWICE ROUND by these classes.

7.3.2 Where Chris Somner (X) mark is specified in any course, replace with RBX mark.

7.4 Re-Crossing the Start Line: After rounding the First Mark of the course, a boat shall not pass between the Outer Distance Mark of the Start or Finish Line and the Race Platform or Committee Boat except to finish the race or a round of the course. This changes RRS 28.1.

7.5 Channel Marks: Where North Channel is defined as a mark of the course, boats shall pass on the channel side of port hand (Red) buoys No's NC2, NC4, NC6, NC8, NC10, NC12. Where a course requires a boat to follow other Channels, all buoys and lighted beacons marking that Channel shall be passed on the Channel side and will constitute designated marks of the course.

7.6 Committee Boat Courses.

7.6.1 Numbered Courses from this Course Book: When a numbered course from the course book is designated, boats shall proceed to the First Mark and then complete the course as listed, finishing at the Race Platform Finish Line.

7.6.2 Ad-hoc Courses: When an ad-hoc course is set from the Committee Boat competitors shall cross the Committee Boat Finish Line on completion of each round of the course and the race shall finish on the Committee Boat Finish Line.

8.0 THE FINISH

8.1 Race Platform

8.1.1 Finish Line 1: This shall be between the Black and Yellow Post on the Race Platform and the Outer Distance Mark which will be a Buoy with an Orange flag

8.1.2 Finish Line 2: This shall be between the Blue Post on the Race Platform and a Buoy with a Blue flag.

8.2 Committee Boat: Finish Line. This shall be between the Black and Yellow signal mast on the Committee Boat and a buoy with a Blue flag normally set on the opposite side of the Committee Boat to the start line.

9.0 TIME LIMIT. RRS 35 shall not apply.

9.1 Any boat not finishing within the time schedule set out below shall be deemed to have retired. When no boat finishes within the prescribed time limit the race shall be abandoned. The time limit for all races shall be 3 hours unless stated below.

9.1.1 Evening races (level rating) – **2045 hours**.

9.1.2 Evening races (handicap) – **2045 hours**. When one boat finishes within the time limit this limit is extended such that any boat in the same class finishing within 30 minutes of the first boat will be given a finishing position. When the time limit has been extended the appropriate class flag will be displayed at the finishing line until the extended time limit has expired

9.1.3 Wednesday afternoons - **1730 hours**.

9.1.4 Saturday afternoons - **1815 hours**.

9.2 Stragglers: Any boat which is significantly separated behind the body of the fleet (but which would be likely to finish within the time limit) may be awarded a finishing position whilst still on the course. This is at the discretion of the Race Officer.

10.0 PROTESTS.(INCLUDE ARBITRATION ARRANGEMENTS)

10.1 Frivolous Protests: Any boat bringing a protest deemed to be frivolous by the Protest Committee shall itself be disqualified.

10.2 Protests: Shall be written on forms available from the Club Office, Beachmaster's Office, Sailing Office or the Bar.

10.3 Time Limits: Protests shall be lodged within one hour of finishing the race in question, but within three hours in respect of Cruiser, J24, Shrimper, 2 race days and Bay races or on two race days (see 4.10).

10.4 Hearings: Protest hearings will normally be held the following week, after the end of all racing. However, the date and time of the hearing will be confirmed by the schedule posted on the Sailing Secretary's Notice Board. Application by a party to a protest to vary the time of hearing shall be made in good time and with good reason.

10.5 Arbitration:

10.5.1 On the day the incident occurs, an arbitration system may be used as an alternative to a full protest hearing. Under this system, a protest shall be decided by the protest arbitrator, or designated substitute. Such arbitration shall replace the protest hearing required under RRS 63. This system may only be used if, prior to the arbitration, all the parties agree to the arbitration and accept that the arbitrator's decision is final. If any party declines to accept arbitration, a full protest hearing shall take place on another date, when any rule infringement may result in disqualification.

10.5.2 The arbitrator shall first decide if the protest is valid. All parties shall have the opportunity of stating their case. The arbitrator shall have total discretion as to whether any witness be called. At the conclusion of the arbitration hearing the arbitrator will reach a decision. Any such decision shall be final; however a request for a re-opening may be made under RRS 66.

10.5.3 Any party found to have infringed a rule shall not be disqualified but shall instead incur a penalty of 35% of the number of starters in that race (rounded up). No penalty shall result in a score that would exceed a disqualification. Application of a penalty shall not affect the place, or score, of the other competitors in that race.

10.5.4 At any time during the hearing the arbitrator may terminate the arbitration and refer the incident to the full protest committee.

11.0 POINTS AND TROPHIES.

11.1 Points: The scoring system for all Points Series will be determined by each Class. All scoring systems shall be detailed in writing and available on request.

11.2 Trophies: Temporary Members are not eligible for any trophies or cups other than those for Open Events.

A number indicates the number of rounds the full course shall be sailed. Competitors shall cross the Finish Line at the end of each round.

The ○ sign will be used only when the course consists of 3 marks which are to be rounded as follows:

Rounds One & Three: First Mark, Second Mark, Third Mark,
Rounds Two & Four: First Mark, Third Mark.

Competitors shall cross the Finish Line at the end of each round.

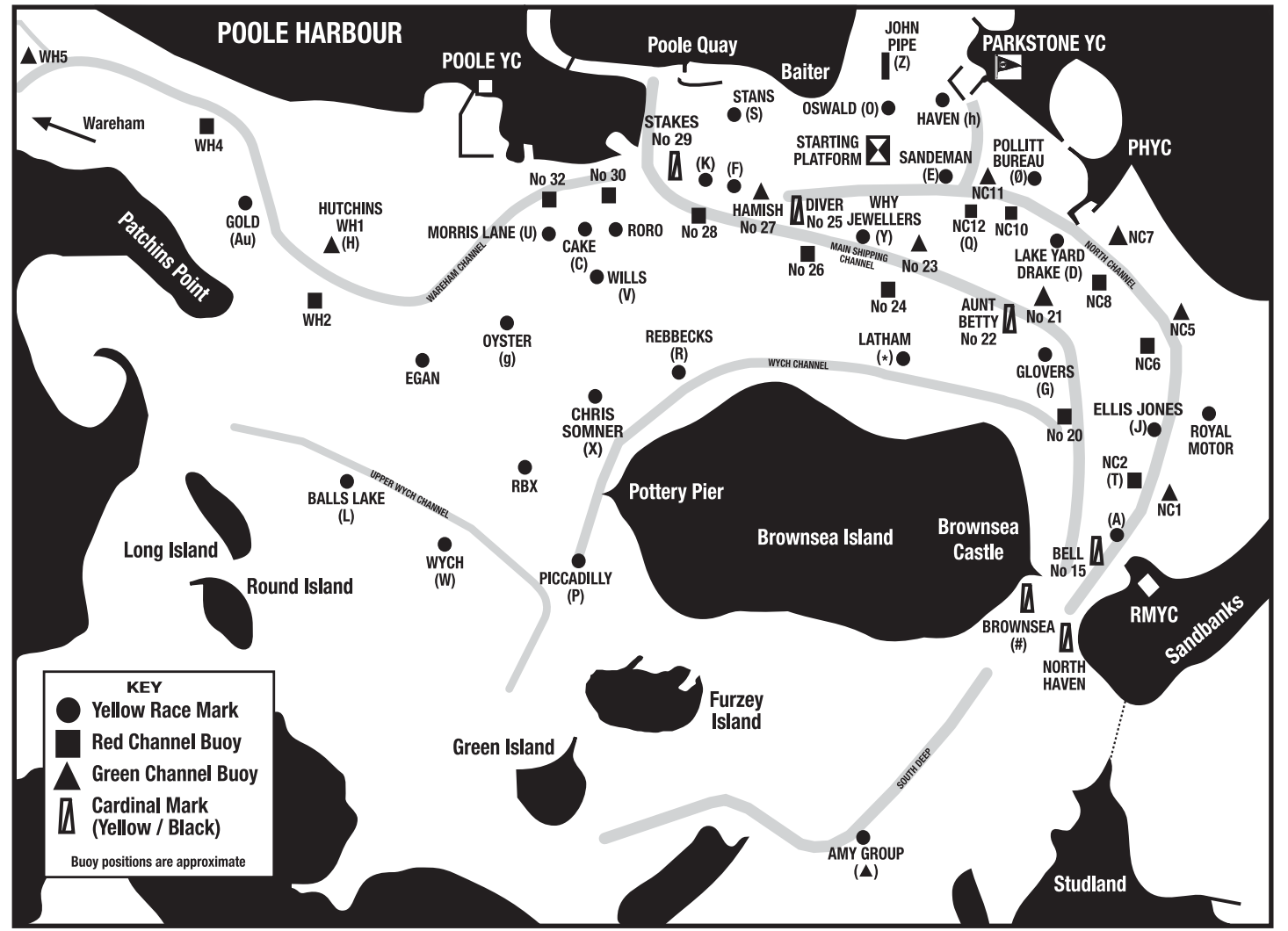
