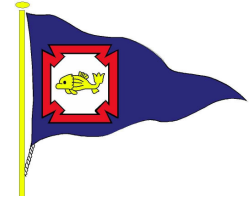

## NOTICE OF RACE

### RS200 Open Meeting 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> May, 2010 Gul RS Grand Prix Series



This notice is a supplement to the RS Class Association General Notice of Race 2010.

**Rules:** The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS), the RYA Prescriptions, Class Rules and the Sailing Instructions (SI's) for the event.

**Liability:** Attention is drawn to the LIABILITY conditions on the Entry Form which must be accepted by each entry.

**Eligibility:** Boats holding a Valid Class Measurement Certificate and insured at all times to a minimum of £2,000,000 Third Party Liability. Measurement Certificates must be presented at time of registration.

**Advertising:** Boats may advertise as per RRS Appendix 1, Category C.

**Entry Fee:** A single fee of £40.00 per boat, which includes payment for 2 meals on Saturday evening.

**Registration:** Will be from 0900 hrs on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> May in the Clubs Main Office. All Competitors must complete an entry form and register before racing.

**Sailing Instructions:** Will be available at Registration.

**Briefing:** for all competitors will be held in the Clubhouse at 1100 hrs on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2010.

**Racing Area:** Racing will take place in Poole Bay, generally to the South and East of the Harbour entrance. Competitors should allow at least 45 mins to reach the racing area. In the event of adverse weather conditions, an alternative racing area within Poole Harbour may be used. This will be notified in accordance with SI's.

**Warning Signal Times:** There are three races scheduled to be run back to back, for each class on each day.

Saturday 8th May, 2010      First warning signal    1255 hrs

Sunday 9th May, 2010      First warning signal    1055 hrs  
The last warning signal on Sunday will be no later than 1555 hrs.

**Scoring:** The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A will apply. Two completed race will form a series. If four or more races are completed then each competitor's worst score will be discarded.

**Prizes:** Will be awarded for the first 3 places in Gold, Silver and Bronze fleets. There will also be a prize for the highest placed Parkstone Yacht Club boat. Other prizes may be awarded depending on entries.

**Catering:** Catering will be available in the club house. Saturday evening there will be a curry after sailing and possibly a drinks event in the bar. 2 curry tickets are included in the entry fee. Further tickets will be available from the Main Office at registration.
