

St David's Day Cruise - 1st/2nd March **(revised Frostbite Cruise)**

The Frostbite Cruise has now been rearranged for the weekend of 1st/2nd March. Since it should be a little warmer by then, "frostbite" would be an inaccurate description. Hence it is now called the "St David's Day cruise". Any suggestions will be welcome for a suitable competition involving leeks!

Saturday 1st March: LW Poole ~10.00am and favourable tide through Hurst until about 16.30, so late morning departure to either Lymington or Yarmouth. Depending on the number and size of boats there may be an option to use the LTSC pontoon. It is not really feasible to go much further up the Solent without incurring the penalty of a very early return departure on Sunday. Dinner will be arranged at a suitable hostelry or yacht club for the Saturday night.

Sunday 2nd March: Tide is favourable through Hurst until about 10.30, so probably depart about 9.00 for the return to Poole. Very neap tides so the foul tide across Poole Bay shouldn't be much of a problem. Potentially back at PYC for a late Sunday lunch - it is Mother's Day.
