

Swanage Cruise Tuesday 15 April

The intention is to sail on the ebb tide to Swanage Bay, have lunch, and then return on the flood.

Unfortunately Swanage SC will not be manned and to date I have not been able to raise the Water Taxi on 07802 480139 so we shall have to make our own arrangements to go ashore if desired. If there is a volunteer with an appropriate dory please let me know.

Low water is just after 13.00 so if we meet in the club at 10.00, to review the weather forecast and let me list and circulate boat names, and mobile numbers.

Communication – VHF Channel 77 or mobile phone

Suggested anchorage – North of the pier, but avoid the commercial moorings and leave access for the ferries going to the pier. Swanage SC mooring buoys are available to us.

Beware - for those who haven't been to Swanage before:

1. There is a rip tide flow over Peveril Ledge at the western end of Swanage
2. There is a diving centre, watch for the relevant flags.
3. Anchorage is variable.

It would be helpful if those projecting to come would let me know by email their names, boat name and mobile number – then I can have a list to circulate before we meet.

Lets hope the weather is kind .
