Welcome



We look forward to receiving your entry for this year's Parkstone Yacht Club Youth Week. Youth Week 2011 is scheduled for Saturday 6th August until Friday 12th August. The racing may not start until the Sunday but the fun starts on the Saturday, following morning registration, with Class parties which are an excellent way for visitors to meet the rest of their fleet.

As in previous years your volunteer committee has put together a busy week of sailing with on and off the water entertainment. Monday and Thursday are the 'all-day' sailing days this year and the regular favourites of 'Water Wars' and 'Splashdown' are on Sunday and Wednesday respectively.

Sailing will be split between two fleets as usual; 'Orange' and 'White' with a scheduled 14 races for the senior fleets and between 8 to 12 races for the AB and Optimist fleets. An added attraction this year will be one long race on Wednesday afternoon – 'Round the Island', although what 'island' will depend on the fleet and the weather conditions.

The Hog Roast on Monday night will be held on the new grass terrace in front on the club house and will be followed by a band for the older (under 19!) competitors. The theme for the Friday night party is Bollywood with the Usual Suspects providing the music. The bacon buttie stand will be open each day for pre-sailing grub with free 'buttie' vouchers for those on Rescue Boat and Race Officer duties that day.

The entry fee includes the BBQ for competitors and all entertainment. Extra tickets for the BBQ (for parents) and the Hog Roast should be pre-ordered using the entry fees page, although there may be limited availability at Registration for additional tickets. Please book early to avoid disappointment. You can order lunches for the whole week on the entry form, though the cost has had to rise a little from 2010. For Orange Course competitors this will be offered as a packed lunch on Monday and Thursday.

Registration will be from 10.30-Noon on Saturday 6th August, and there will be a volunteering booth to fill all those last minute vacancies that must be filled in order to make the week run smoothly.

You will be aware that the club rules dictate that all under 16 year olds are supervised whilst on club premises. This means that parents are expected to be present, or that there are robust 'in loco parentis' arrangements in place. **Please do not enter your children for Youth Week if you cannot meet this requirement.**

The YW11 T-shirt will be free this year to all those entered before 1st July 2011; please nominate your size on the entry fees page (see website for size guide). You can also order a Hoodie on the entry form. In order to allow time for the garments to be printed and embroidered we need these orders by 1st July.
